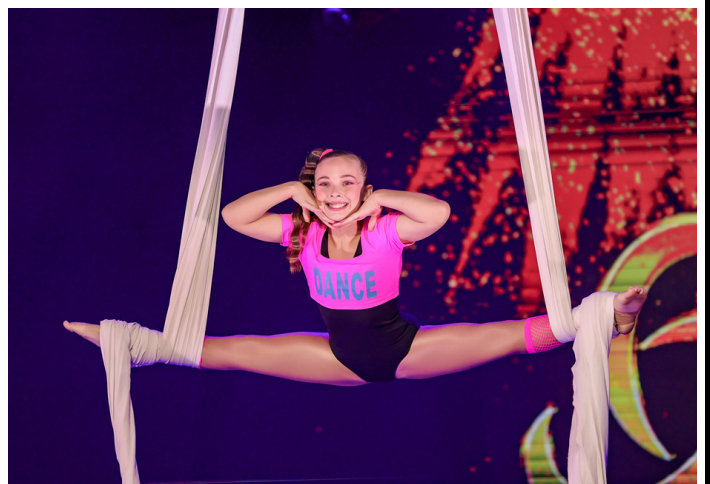

REGISTRATION & ENTRY

How to enter your routine:

Complete the online entry form & pay your registration & entry fee to secure your place in the National Final before the closing date.

Note: Late fees will apply after these dates or your entry may not be accepted.

ENTRY CLOSING DATE: SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 2

MUSIC UPLOAD DEADLINE: SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 30

Follow these steps to complete your finals entry:

1. Login to Dance Comp Genie
2. Click "Add New Registration"
3. Select "National Finals" event - enter password **BTANF25**
4. Complete entry form (Optional - you can upload your performer image here).
5. Continue to checkout to pay your registration + entry fee
6. Click "Upload Music" on the registration on the dashboard and attach your music file.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW DO I QUALIFY FOR THE NATIONAL FINALS?

To qualify for the National Finals you must compete in one of the Bend The Air regional competitions throughout the year and place 1st, 2nd or 3rd in your section or receive a 'wild card' entry.

CAN I QUALIFY FOR MORE THAN 1 SECTION?

Yes, you can qualify for up to **one** routine per category (i.e. Silks, Lyra, Open Apparatus Solo, Open Apparatus Performance Solo, Open Apparatus Duo, Acrobatics & Circus Solo, Acrobatics & Circus Duo/Trio.). Studios entering Acrobatic & Circus Groups can qualify more than one group per age category (e.g. you can qualify 2 x 12 & under Acrobatic & Circus groups).

If you happen to qualify for multiple skill levels for the same apparatus throughout the year (e.g. Intermediate Lyra and Advanced Lyra) you can only compete in the highest qualified level at the National Final. If you happen to qualify for multiple age categories (e.g. Open Apparatus 18 + and Open Apparatus Masters, you can only complete in one section.

CAN I COMPETE/QUALIFY AT MORE THAN ONE REGIONAL EVENT?

Yes, you can compete at more than one regional event throughout the year for an opportunity to qualify for the National Final. You can only enter 1 routine per section at the Finals even if you have qualified more than once. If you have already qualified for a section and you place again at another regional event, the qualifying position will be offered to the next highest score in the section via Wild Card selection.

CAN I ENTER MORE SECTIONS THAN I QUALIFIED FOR?

You can only enter 1 routine per section that you have qualified for.

DO I HAVE TO SUBMIT AN AUDITION VIDEO FOR THE NATIONAL FINALS?

No, as you have already been assessed by the review panel and deemed safe for performing at competition level, you do not need to resubmit an audition video. It is your responsibility to ensure that your routine adheres to the category requirements and restrictions to avoid deductions or disqualification.

DO I HAVE TO PERFORM THE SAME ROUTINE FOR THE NATIONAL FINALS?

Your routine does not need to be the same as the routine (or music) that you performed at the regional event (however, it can be the same if you choose). If making changes to your routine, please make sure that you still adhere to the routine requirements and restrictions for your section to avoid deductions. If you have qualified for an open apparatus division, your apparatus must be the same as the one you used at the regional event.

IS THE ROUTINE CRITERIA THE SAME FOR THE NATIONAL FINALS?

Yes, the routine criteria set in the competition kits for the regional events will remain the same for the National Finals. Be sure you consider the routine requirements and restrictions to avoid deductions.

WHAT IF MY AGE CHANGES BEFORE THE NATIONAL FINALS?

All ages are taken from January 1, 2025. You will still compete in the age category you qualified for, even if your age changes before the finals.

WHAT HEIGHT WILL THE AERIAL RIG BE?

Rigging will be using the Alta Rig at the National Finals. This has a set height of 7m which allows for approximately 6.5m of aerial working space, once you take into consideration the mat and rigging hardware.

WHAT SIZE WILL THE STAGE BE?

For Aerial sections the stage will be the 6 x 6m grey mat flooring underneath the footprint of the Alta Rig. Acrobatics & Circus sections will have the use of the full stage area (approximately 12m x 11m).

WILL THERE BE A WARM UP RIG?

There will not be a warm up rig available on site at the theatre venue. There may be some local studios who are running open training sessions inviting BTA competitors.

DO I NEED TO PROVIDE MY OWN APPARATUS?

As per the regional events, you will have the option to BYO apparatus or use the in-house apparatus'. We have available - SILKS (White, Red), LYRA (75cm Hollow, 85cm Hollow, 90cm Hollow, 90cm Solid), HAMMOCK (3m Navy).

HOW MANY DAYS AM I REQUIRED TO BE AT THE EVENT?

The draft schedule shows you which day each section will be on. You are only required to be onsite the days you are performing. There will be a rig check prior to the session start for all aerial sections (same process as regional events). All National Champions are invited to perform at the Gala event which is on Sunday, accepting your performance in this show is optional.

WILL THERE BE WORKSHOPS AND OTHER EVENTS AS PART OF THE FINALS?

There is a series of workshops for both competitors and coaches, planned to take place at Just Acrobatics in Warana on Monday, January 19. More information on the schedule and how to book will be released soon!

DO I NEED TO BUY A TICKET?

Spectator tickets will go on sale closer to the event. All competitors will receive a competitor pass to allow you to watch from the audience (where seats are available) for the entire competition (excluding the Gala event). There will also be a live stream with tickets available to purchase.

WILL MY ROUTINE BE FILMED & PHOTOGRAPHED?

Limelight Multimedia will be filming all routines to produce high quality, professional videos from multiple camera angles. Artistry Photography will be taking photographs of all routines. Both your photos & videos will be available to purchase. More details on pricing and how to purchase will be sent closer to the event.

WILL THERE BE FINALS MERCHANDISE?

We will have exclusive finals merchandise available for purchase for pre-order and limited stock available to purchase at the event. More information on the design and how to pre-order will be released soon.
